

170-300-0055**Developmental screening, communication to parents or guardians**

- (1) An early learning provider must inform parents or guardians about the importance of developmental screenings for each child from birth through age five. An early learning provider must keep documentation of this communication to parents in the facility records.
- (2) An early learning provider must share information with parents or guardians about organizations that conduct developmental screenings such as a local agency, school district, health care provider, or specialist.

170-300-0065**School readiness and family engagement activities**

An early learning provider must supply kindergarten or school readiness materials at least once per calendar year, such as those posted online by OSPI or the department, to a parent or guardian concerning:

- (a) Kindergarten transition activities if a child is ready to transition to kindergarten; and
- (b) Developmentally appropriate local school and school district activities designed to engage families.
